The Embassy of the Republic of Italy presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey and has the honour to inform that the Politecnico di Torino is promoting a course of "Bachelor's Degree in Textile Engineering". The initiative is supported by the Industrialists Association of Biella, which coordinates the scholarships sponsored by the Italian textile companies and associations.

The course will be held in the premises of the "Città Studi Biella", founded 25 years ago by the local industrial association in order to increase the scientific and technological development of the local industry, mainly devoted to the textile sector. Today "Città Studi Biella" represents one of the most important centres of the industrial culture in Italy.

The aim of the Bachelor's Degree course in Textile Engineering is to promote the development of economic relations between Italy and some "key Countries", among which Turkey, through the training of students.

The participants will be granted €30.000 over the whole course period (€10.000 per year), while receiving free accommodation at the University residences of the Citta' Studi Biella.
