Admission of Foreign Nationals for Academic Session 2008-2009

Application of Foreign nationals can be submitted till 20 February, 2009 for admission in the undergraduate courses of this university for the session 2008-2009. Only those candidates who passed the Higher Secondary Certificate (H.S.C.) examination or its equivalent in 2008 or GCE A level examination after November 2007 are eligible to apply, subject to fulfillment of other conditions.

**1. Eligibility criteria**

- (a) Foreign nationals having their education in foreign countries shall be considered as 'foreign' Students
- (b) Candidates must have passed higher secondary examination or GCE A level examination or its equivalent examination from a foreign education board with minimum 'B' grades in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry.

**2. Number of seats**

The total number of seats for foreign students in undergraduate level in a single academic session is 26 (twenty six). However, a maximum of 10 (ten) students from a single country and a maximum of 5 (five) students in a single department shall be allowed.

**3. Procedure for submission of application**

Application for admission must be submitted through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Government of Bangladesh. The relevant documents of educational qualifications and 4 (four) recently taken color photographs of the candidate should be included with the application form. After receiving the applications, the Admission Committee will select the eligible candidates for Admission in order of merit.

**4. Cost of study**

The tuition and other fees for undergraduate studies for students from SAARC countries will be charged as per regulations of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. The students from non-SAARC countries will be charged US\$ 1000 (one thousand) only per term. The approximate cost for food, lodging, etc. is about US\$ 150 (one hundred fifty US dollars) only per month.
